**SYRACUSE, NY** – More than 1,000 business and community leaders gathered at CenterState CEO's Annual Meeting, held at the Nicholas J. Pirro Convention Center at Oncenter, in Syracuse.

"We are incredibly proud of the team that accomplished this successful project and grateful to the community for its support and engagement."

Appellate Section, Environment and Natural Resources division; and law clerk for Stephen Breyer, then Chief Justice United States Court of Appeals for the First Circuit and now Justice of the Supreme Court.

Throughout her career, Adams has held academic positions as adjunct assistant professor of law for the New York University Law School and adjunct assistant professor of environmental law for Columbia University Law School in New York City.

She earned a bachelor's degree in Comparative Literature with French and German concentrations from Brown University and a law degree from the University of Chicago Law School in Chicago, Illinois.
